The Metcalf/Shawnee Mission Parkway Transit Corridor Project will include:

- 20 transit stations,
- two park-and-ride facilities,
- pedestrian access improvements Metcalf Avenue from 87th to College Boulevard,
- pedestrian access and road reconstruction improvements at Broadmoor and Martway,
- a transit signal priority system, which will improve bus timing and efficiency; and
- a transit center adjacent to Mission's downtown, to support existing transit service and future local bus service.

Renderings of transit stations, park-and-ride facilities, and bus stops will be on display, as will landscape plans and the new logo for this route. Representatives from Johnson County Transit, the cities of Overland Park, Mission and Roeland Park and project team members will be available to answer questions about the proposed improvements. Construction is expected to begin in November 2011 and conclude in Summer 2012.
